A cancellation form must be filled out and returned Kathy Morrisey at 1012 Haddonhall Dr. one week prior to the first official TSA swim meet in order for a refund to be issued. There is a \$10 nonrefundable processing fee per swimmer. Nonattendance does not entitle you to a refund. This includes failure to attend due to illness, vacation, or inclement weather.

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Parent Volunteer Commitment Form

When a child joins a swim team, so do the parents. This sport requires parents to be participants, not just spectators. It takes so many people to run a meet that there is literally a job for everyone. Training for some jobs takes only a few minutes; others require attendance at clinics. None are as scary or difficult as you might think. Please make sure that one member of your family works at least 4 jobs during the swim season. One of which must be the Mock Meet. In total, approximately 40 volunteers are required to run a meet. *Additional* volunteers allow everyone to take breaks during the meet. **Volunteer positions are selected at Registration. Following Registration positions may be selected on the Swim Team Website.**

**** WEDNESDAY NIGHT DUE TO JULY 4TH HOLIDAY**

MEET POSITIONS:

Every open position is easily learned, requires no prior experience, and you don't have to do it alone.

- A) **Meet Setup/Takedown** (HOME ONLY) – Guided by the Equipment Manager, sets up backstroke flags, starting blocks, lane ropes, chairs behind blocks, scoring, ribbon and announcer tables, and temporary lights. Distributes vests and stopwatches to officials. You need to arrive at the pool by 4:00 pm to get the pool ready for warm ups which begin at 5:00pm. Gets the facility back in order following the meet, collects trash, puts away lane ropes, starting blocks, backstroke flags, 6-under finish rope, lights, and PA system.
- B) **Announcer** (HOME ONLY) – Calls swimmers to Clerk of Course. Welcomes the visiting team to our pool, announces team scores throughout the evening.
- C) **Starter** – (HOME ONLY) -- The starter has complete control of swimmers delivered to the starting blocks by the Clerk of Course. Announces the distance and stroke or relay event and uses the commands "Swimmers step up," (or "step in the water" for backstroke,) "Timers and judges ready," "Swimmers take your mark," etc. and presses the starting device button at the appropriate time. This position remains stationary at the starting end of the pool.
- D) **Clerk of Course** - (HOME AND AWAY) – When the announcer calls for each gender/age group for each event to report to the Clerk of Course, you will get swimmers to the proper lanes for each event and hand event sheets to the Recorders. You MAY combine events with the approval of the TSA Rep. You will get to meet all of the swimmers and give them a word of encouragement as they line up to swim. You will be moving around at the starting end of the pool. **(Must be able to arrive WELL Before the start time of the meet.)**
- E) **Stroke and Turn Judge** (HOME AND AWAY) - Observes the main event swimmers looking for disqualifying motions. These judges must learn what to look for and disqualify swimmers in point-scoring events who commit violations. Heats are not judged. This judge stands on the side of the pool. Required to attend a TSA one-hour class. Each team provides one judge per meet.
- F) **Place Judge** – (HOME AND AWAY) - Observes the finish order for the point-scoring heats (Main Events). You will stand at the finish end of the pool and you will communicate the finish results to the recorder. You have no duties during non-scoring heats. You will be moving about the pool deck throughout the meet. Each team supplies three place judges at each meet.
- G) **Timer** (HOME AND AWAY) - Times all of our team's swimmers at dual meets. (1 timer per lane) Writes down times and provides a record of your lane's time and swimmer # (written on swimmer's arms or legs) to the team Recorder.
- H) **Time Recorder** - (HOME ONLY) - Completes event sheets by recording the order of finish and times according to the place judges and timers.

- I) **Runner** (HOME AND AWAY) - Takes event sheets from the recorder and disqualification sheets from stroke and turn judges and carries them to the scorer's table. The runner must deliver the sheets directly to the scorer's table and not allow coaches or other interested parties to see them in transit. This is a mobile position. Wear comfortable shoes.
- J) **Kid Pushers** - (HOME AND AWAY) – Supervises an age group of boys or girls during the meet and delivers swimmers to the Clerk of Course according to the meet lineup sheets prepared in advance by the coach showing each swimmer's events. You will be responsible for making sure all swimmers in your group have their swimmer number (tattoo) printed on each arm where it will be visible from the front and the side. You will be moving about the pool deck, primarily between the team sitting area and the starting end. Must arrive at the pool by 4:30 for home meets and 5:00 for away meets.
- K) **Ribbon Distributor** - (HOME ONLY) – Stands at the finish end of the pool and hands “Heat Winner” ribbons to the winner of each heat. Also passes out “Participant” ribbons to non-heat winners and commends them as they come out of the water. *Judges are not responsible for determining the heat winner, so the ribbon distributor must be watching during these races.*
- L) **Ribbon Writer** – (HOME AND AWAY) – Sitting at the ribbon table, the Ribbon Writer records the swimmer's name and event on the back of each place ribbon. You will receive the results on the main event sheets after the scorer has recorded the necessary information. You will have a supply of ribbons and a roster for each team. Once written, you'll file the ribbons into the swimmers' files for pick-up at the next practice.
- M) **Scorer** – (HOME AND AWAY) - Keeps a running total of points earned by each team. You will work with the other team's scorer. You will receive results for each main event and give 5 points to first place, 3 points to second, and 1 point to third (relays received points for first place only). You use a preprinted scoring sheet that is easy to understand. You will be seated at the scoring table. A sheet explaining scoring will be available at each meet.
- N) **Concessions** (HOME ONLY) - Helps the Concessions Chair with the concession stand at home meets. This position MAY involve some pre-meet preparation, if requested by the Chair.

All families will be sent reminder e-mails about their designated volunteer commitments during the week before each meet. **You will be responsible for your OWN replacement should you not be able to fulfill your original commitment.** Please contact another Hammerhead parent to switch with you or to take your place, then contact the Volunteer Coordinator to let them know who will be replacing you. At the beginning of the season, you will be provided with a complete volunteer list that will contain names, phone numbers, and e-mail addresses of all Hammerhead families AND contact info for our Volunteer Coordinator. If you fail to find your own replacement, your name will be placed on an “available volunteer” list that may be viewed on the Hammerheads Web Site – hh-hammerheads.net. Questions?
